



What Memorial Day means to me

Memorial Day is celebrated on the last day in May. Several towns claim to be the originators of Memorial Day, but in 1966 Congress declared Waterloo, New York, to be the birthplace of the holiday. Memorial Day originally honored military personnel who died in the Civil War (1861-1865). The holiday now honors those who died in any war while serving with the United States. It is also called Decoration Day.



Across the United States Memorial Day is celebrated with parades that often include military personnel and members of veterans' organizations. Some of the largest parades take place in Chicago, New York and Washington D.C. It is also observed by visiting cemeteries and memorials.

In my family very few served in the military. In fact, I believe only one cousin served. David Castro, my second cousin. He was deployed to Iraq 3 times. He did not die at war, but due to PTSD he died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound. He left behind 4 children and his wife. David was a great father, brother and son. He loved serving our country and was proud to be a soldier. He was awarded the Army Commendation Medal which is awarded to any member of the Armed Forces of the United States other than General Officers who, while serving in any capacity with the U.S. Army after December 6, 1941, distinguished themselves by heroism, meritorious achievement or meritorious service. David was only 44 years old. He is buried in Fort Hood, Texas.




